## **Job Summary**

A Northern Water Smart Instructor is responsible for the preparation and delivery of Lifesaving programs in Northern Saskatchewan communities. These programs include Swim to Survive® swimming lessons, Water Smart® public education, First Aid training, and water rescue. This position requires extensive travel; mostly driving and some fly-in may be involved. Vehicle is supplied by Society.

#### **Main Duties**

- Delivery of Lifesaving Society programs including Swim to Survive®, Swim for Life®, First Aid, and B.O.A.T. ®
- Promotion of Water Smart® public education in the communities.
- In cooperation with the Branch and host communities, coordinate visits and ensure that needs are met.
- Participation in staff orientation and training.
- Lesson planning and preparation of equipment and/or teaching tools.
- Pre and post season work in Society Branch office may be required.
- Complete follow up reports as required.
- Various other tasks as assigned by Special Projects Manager or Chief Executive Officer

## Requirements

- Current Lifesaving Instructor (Completion of mentorships is preferred)
- Current Lifesaving Society National Lifeguard Award
- Current Standard First Aid/CPR C/AED or Aquatics Emergency Care
- Criminal Record Check and Child Abuse Registry Check
- Valid Class 5 License
- Ability to work alone and/or in a team
- Preference will be given to post-secondary students who are returning to their studies in September 2020
