**Who you are:**

- You enjoy working outdoors and teaching swimming lesson in open water,
- You bring fun and creativity to your teaching,
- You are a supportive and productive instructor with a high level of adaptability, and
- You can work with minimal supervision.

**Duties & Responsibilities:**

- Instruction of the Lifesaving Society's Swim for Life program (Preschool, Swimmer).
- Instruction of the Lifesaving Society's Swim Patrol program (Rookie, Ranger, Star).
- Instruction of the Lifesaving Society's Bronze Family programs (Star, Medallion, Cross). If required to teach Bronze Medallion or Cross, a mentor will be provided.
- Responsible for individual lesson plans, class attendance, ongoing student progress tracking, and completion of progress reports of all students.
- Carries out responsible instructional duties and ensures a safe environment conducive to aquatic education.
- Carries out instructional duties in a fun and engaging manner, creating a welcoming environment for all participants.
- Ensure instruction area well maintained and all safety standards are being followed for self and participants
- Continued supervision of all swimming lesson participants during class times.
- Ensures that proper safety procedures are followed and in cases of emergency, performs first aid, water rescues and other lifesaving skills and techniques, as required.
- Recording of incidents that involve both self and participants.
- Maintain a continuous level of customer service and professionalism.
- Participates in mandatory sessional staff training.
- Maintains good public relations with participants and guardians.
- Performs related duties as required.
- Instructors will be responsible for their weekly travel to and from the regional park.

**Qualifications:**

- Current Lifesaving Society Bronze Cross or National Lifeguard,
- Current Standard First Aid & CPR-C/AED, and
- Current Lifesaving Society Swim and Lifesaving Instructor OR will have completed this certification prior to employment start date.

**Working Conditions:**

- Duties are conducted within the assigned regional park, at the public beach. The ideal candidate will be able to adapt to various weather conditions to ensure all lessons are meaningful to participants.
- We urge instructors to communicate and learn from each other, work as a team, and have fun while instructing. Therefore, we are encouraging applicants to apply with a friend or two and we will try to accommodate location and pairing requests.
- Overnight, camping accommodation will be provided from Sunday at 4pm to Saturday at 9am (including a shared, powered site, and tent if required). Sleeping gear, food, etc. will not be provided.

**Hours:** Monday to Friday, 30-40 hours per week.

**Contract Wage:** \$15.00 per hour.

Contact employees will be responsible to pay their own income tax or other income-related obligations.

**Contract Employment:** Weekly, up to 8 weeks.

**Commencement:** July 5 - August 30, 2021.
